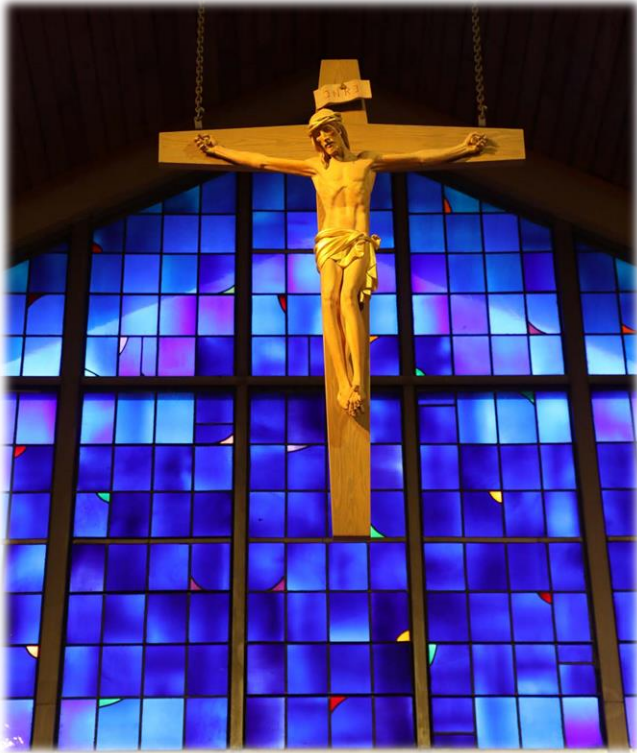

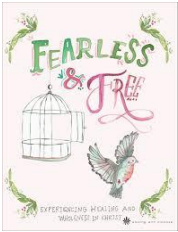

Harmony

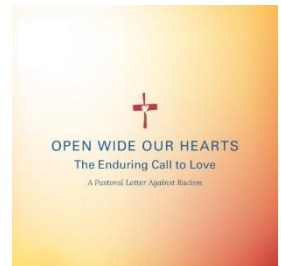

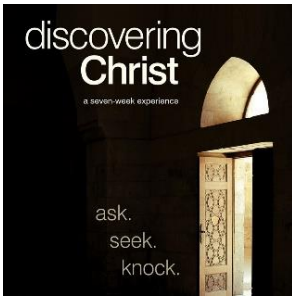
OPEN WIDE YOUR HEARTS

Looking for your PURPOSE in life?

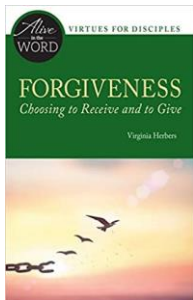

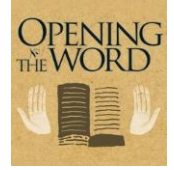

KEEP FIGHTING HUNGER! The St. Rose of Lima parish food donation program provides essential assistance to our food insecure neighbors. With the ongoing pandemic, the need is greater than ever! **We invite you to be part of this anti-hunger initiative.** When you shop for your family, purchase one non-perishable item for those in need. Bring the food to Mass on Sunday to **FEED** the hungry, place it in the collection bin **and BE FED** by the Word of God and Holy Eucharist. A food donation bin is also available 24/7 outside the main doors of the Parish Center. **MARCH FOOD NEEDS:** peanut butter, jelly, canned fruits & vegetables, cereal and oatmeal, whole grain pasta & sauce, canned proteins (chicken, salmon, tuna, beef stew).



LENT CARE BAGS

Help the homeless by filling a Lent Care Bag.
It's easy as 1-2-3

1) During Lent, purchase basic personal care items and non-perishable snack items to fill a jumbo zip-top bag. **2)** Add a cheery note of hope from your family. **3)** Bring the bag to church any Sunday in Lent and place it in the Care Bag collection bin in the church vestibule. **Empty bags and information fliers** are in the church vestibule and available at the donation bin outside the Parish Center.
