Sacraments

THE SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM is celebrated Sundays after the 11:30 am Mass. First time parents are required to attend **Pre-Jordan**, an instructional/sacramental preparation for Baptism. **Pre-Jordan** classes are held on the first Wednesday evening of each month. Pre-registration is required. Contact the parish office to make arrangements.

Requirements to be a Godparent/sponsor:

The Code of Canon Law specifies the following requirements for serving as a godparent or sponsor, so please review them carefully before choosing godparents and sponsors.

- ❖ Must be someone other than the parent of the one to be baptized;
- ❖ Must be at least 16 years of age.
- ❖ Only one godparent is needed. If there will be two godparents (for Baptism), one must be male and one must be female;
- ❖ Must have received all the Sacraments of Initiation: Baptism, Holy Eucharist, Confirmation and actively practicing their faith (attending Mass, receiving Holy Communion and receiving the Sacrament of Penance);
- ❖ If married-he or she must be married in the Catholic Church, or the marriage recognized by the Catholic Church;
- ❖ One godparent may be a non-Catholic Christian Witness with proper proof of his/her baptism. If a non-Catholic is asked to be a Christian Witness, the other godparent **MUST** be Catholic;
- ❖ A person who has left the Catholic Faith for any reason, may not be asked to be a godparent/sponsor;
- ❖ The eligible godparent/sponsor must supply St. Rose of Lima Church with a signed "Certificate of Eligibility" from the Parish where they are registered and attend Mass.

Certificates Of Eligibility: A certificate of Eligibility to be a godparent/sponsor is obtained from the parish where you are registered and attend Mass. If you have been asked to be a godparent/sponsor and you meet all of the above requirements, please call the parish office to obtain a Letter of Eligibility.

THE SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION is offered every Saturday, 3:00 to 3:45 pm, and anytime by appointment.

THE SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE may be scheduled by contacting the Parish Office. The couple must meet with the priest celebrating the wedding at least 6 months before a planned wedding date. No other arrangements should be made until the couple meets with a parish priest and the date and time are confirmed.

Marriage Prep: Marriage Preparation courses can be either through a self-paced, online program, or by attending any in person program offered through a Catholic parish, retreat center, or university within or outside of the Archdiocese of Philadelphia, condition that such programs fully and thoroughly cover all the core theological, spiritual, practical, and intimate aspects of marriage, in conformity to Catholic doctrine. FAST AND ABSTINENCE AND OTHER ACTS OF PENANCE FOR LENT 2026

The Bishops of the United States prescribe, as minimal obligation, that all persons who are fourteen years of age and older are bound to abstain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday, February 18, 2026, on all the Fridays of Lent and Good Friday. Further, all people eighteen years of age and older, up to and including their fifty-ninth birthday, are bound to fast by limiting themselves to a single full meal on Ash Wednesday and on Good Friday, while the other two meals on those days are to be light. All the faithful are encouraged, when possible, to participate at Mass and to receive the Holy Eucharist daily, to celebrate frequently the Sacrament of Penance, to undertake spiritual reading, especially the study of the Sacred Scriptures, and to participate in parish Lenten devotions as well as Lenten education programs. Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament is especially recommended.



STATIONS OF THE CROSS

During Lent, Stations will be on Friday Evenings at 7:00 PM. If you have not attended the Stations of the Cross in a while, this would be a very meaningful way to prepare for Holy Week.

CONFESSIONS Confession will be available on Friday Evenings during Stations of the Cross starting at 7:00 PM and on Saturdays at 3 PM. Make your peace with God, with yourself, and with others.



ADORATION FRIDAYS Come spend time with Jesus every Friday during Lent. Adoration of the Eucharist starts right after the 8:30 AM Mass and continues through Stations of the Cross until 8:00 PM. What a wonderful way to begin the Lenten Season. Jesus is waiting for you. Come when your schedule allows or sign up for an hour every week to be with Jesus.

LENTEN ACTIVITIES

"FAST from THIS - FEAST on THAT" This Lent, beginning this Sunday, Feb. 22, instead of adding more to our to-do list, we are inviting you let go of one habit that weighs you down and intentionally practice one virtue that draws you closer to Christ—one simple focus each week. No sign-ups, no tracking and no guilt if you miss a week. Start again anytime. Each week of LENT we will provide you with: 1 thing to **FAST** from (interior or exterior), 1 thing to **FEAST** on (a virtue or practice) and a short scripture or prayer cue. These VIRTUES will be announced briefly at Mass, printed in the bulletin and shared in our Saturday morning emails.



LENTEN CARE BAGS Provide support for individuals experiencing homelessness. Bags & info fliers will be in the vestibule. **How to participate:** Purchase basic personal care items and non-perishable snacks to fill a jumbo zip-top bag. • Add kind note of hope from your family. • Bring the bag to church any Sunday in Lent and place it in the Care Bag collection bin in the church vestibule.

FEED AND BE FED FOOD DONATION PROGRAM The area food cupboards are continuing to experience a high level of need for donations to assist hungry families in the community. **Items needed in March include:** Peanut Butter, Jelly, Soups, Canned Proteins (chicken, salmon, beef stew), Canned or boxed broth, Canned pasta (Chef Boyardee, Spaghetti O's), Cereal, Oatmeal, Grits, Boxes and/or packets of potatoes, Rice, Canned fruits and vegetables, Coffee, Oatmeal, Pancake mix and syrup, feminine products, and paper products. 



JOIN FATHER TAGLIANETTI FOR A PARISH PILGRIMAGE TO THE NATIONAL CENTRE FOR PADRE PIO



PRAYER SHAWL MINISTRY

Do you know someone that needs “a hug from God” this new year? The Prayer Shawl



Ministry members knit and crochet prayer shawls, scarves, baby blankets, lap blankets and mini squares. Shawls are free and available for any family member, friend, co-worker, neighbor, etc. who might be comforted receiving one. Future recipients of prayer shawls are prayed for from the first stitch, and their special intentions are remembered in prayer by the members of the ministry prayer community. **If you know someone in need of prayer and God's loving embrace**, select a shawl to give to them as a gift. Mini shawls are in the Church vestibule and larger shawls are available at the Parish office.

HOME ENTHRONEMENT- What is it?

To Enthronement your home is simply to make the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary's presence noticed in your home by displaying their pictures somewhere where they will be seen. You can obtain these pictures by spending about 45 minutes with a representative who has been given permission to act as ministers of this service by the pastor. This representative will pray the prayers of consecration from a booklet which you will be given. In doing so, Jesus and Mary are then recognized as “first” in your home, by you and your family or by others. There is no charge for the pictures, the prayers, or the visit. NOURISH FOR CAREGIVERS IS BACK




“I’m so overwhelmed, getting more and more involved in caring for my parents.” “There’s so many decisions to make, I could really use some help.” “How can I be more prepared?”
