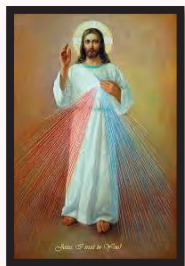

In 1931, Our Lord appeared to St. Faustina in a vision. She saw Jesus in a white robe with his right hand raised in a blessing. His left hand was touching his garment in

the area of his heart, from where two large rays came forth, one red and the other pale. Pope Saint John Paul II, on April 30, 2000, declared that from now on throughout the Church the Second Sunday of Easter will also be called Divine Mercy Sunday.

*The message of divine mercy is simple, it is that GOD loves us- all of us. And he wants us to recognize His mercy is greater than our sins, so that we will call upon Him with trust, receive His mercy, and let it flow through us to others. This beautiful prayer service includes Adoration, Confessions, Divine Mercy Chaplet and Benediction. **ALL ARE INVITED! Remember to pick up the Novena chaplet in the vestibule or at each door.***

THANK YOU FOR CARE BAG DONATIONS!

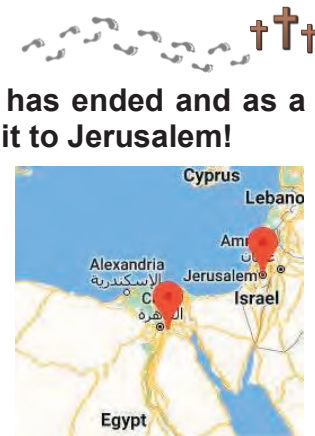
